- 6) representative work published in the past five years (published after August 2017; Chinese or English introduction and abstract required if not published in Chinese / English; at least two if representative works are journal papers or book chapters and one for books) (doctoral dissertations used to apply for an assistant professorship not need have been published);
- 7) reference work published in the past seven years (five at most, published after August 2015);
- 8) syllabi for three or more courses related to the applicant's research field.
